

Parish Financial Assistance:

Parents who enroll their child in any Catholic School may request financial assistance for grades **1-8** from their *home parish*, by sending a subsidy request to their pastor. St. Joseph parishioners must submit a subsidy request to Fr. Stephen Banjare by April 14th. (Forms are available in the school office). Non-parishioners need to contact their own pastors.

Diocesan Financial Assistance:

Additional financial assistance based on family need is also available through FACE (Foundation to Advance Catholic Education) for students in grades **K-8**. The application process is completed online, and we will be more than happy to assist anyone who may need help with this online process. Once financial aid is verified, monthly tuition payments will be adjusted.

No diocesan financial aid is available for Preschool, however, tuition expenses for Preschool and Kindergarten may be tax deductible. Please consult your tax advisor for further information

PACE vouchers:

St. Joseph School accepts payment for preschool and aftercare services through PACE Child Care Works. PACE is a part of the Massachusetts Child Care Resource and Referral Network and administers the Voucher Management Program to help low-income families get the child care they deserve.

Tuition Payment Options:

- Payment in full, check, cash or credit card, on or before July 1
- Monthly payments **ONLY** available through the FACTS Tuition Management Program over a period of 11 months beginning in July. Parents may select the 5th or 20th of the month for automatic bank payments
